Therapist must have experience and interest in working with parents of their youth clients, and are passionate about utilizing family systems theory and up-to-date parenting strategies in their work. We are currently looking for therapists who are anti-racist, social justice minded, and ready to be a part of a dynamic, fun, and collaborative team.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Perform on-site clinical counseling services to patients of Empower Family Therapy, as scheduled, and in accordance with company policies.
- Regular and reliable attendance and timely arrival to work is required.
- Be properly licensed and abide by all laws, rules, regulations, and codes of ethics that are binding upon or applicable to the services performed for Empower Family Therapy.
- Respond to patients' requests for service or calls within 24 hours whether such requests are made in person, by phone, voicemail, etc. or through the Empower Family Therapy website. Respond to such requests by meeting, evaluating, and providing services to such patients.
- Communicate with a patient's treatment team (i.e., PCP, psychiatrist, school, etc.) as necessary.



- Timely complete written records for each patient including, but not limited to: intake
 notes, progress notes, treatment plans, termination notes, contract notes, and other
 forms or documents which may be needed or required from time-to-time by Empower
 Family Therapy or third parties in conjunction with the treatment of the patient within a
 timely fashion. Keep patient files accurate and up to date according to company policies.
- Charge patients for services provided consistent with the policy and rate for such services as established by Empower Family Therapy.
- Attend mandatory staff meetings and training as directed by Empower Family Therapy.
- Availability for select weekday evenings & weekends appointments
- Conduct and regulate counseling services in a professional manner so as to maintain and increase the good will and reputation of Empower Family Therapy. Be respectful of and cooperative and collaborative with co-workers.
- Passion for working with others (being collaborative) and helping our team members grow and learn.
- Other duties as may be assigned.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Align with Empower Family Therapy mission, vision, and values.
- Must be punctual in reporting to work and appointments
- Master's Degree or Doctoral Degree in counseling or social work; and
- If licensed, a copy of your active, unrestricted license (PhD, PsyD, LCSW, LMFT or LCPC) in the State of Illinois or Florida, must be provided to Empower Family Therapy.
- Available to hold at least 20 patient sessions per week, provided such sessions are available and referred/scheduled by Empower Family Therapy.
- Be organized and detail oriented.
- Be a team player.
- Be able to work independently on tasks assigned.
- Have strong written and verbal communication skills and strong interpersonal skills.
- Prior work experience required, experience in a counseling setting highly preferred.
- At least three years' couple and/or family work experience preferred.
- Ability to demonstrate mastery of couple and family clinical skills and strategies, and a systemic approach to therapy.
- Have at least one niche market for counseling services (i.e., children, teens, trauma, anxiety, grief, anger management, etc.) in addition to couples and family work.
- Current approval as an in-network provider with BCBS (highly preferred).

The perfect candidate would be:



- An AMFT or LMFT. We would be willing to consider candidates with other licensures
 who have had significant experience and/or training working with couples and families
 with a systemic lens.
- Availability to maintain a full-time in office schedule with weekday evening and weekend availability
- Has a marketable niche or area of expertise within the scope of couples, families, parenting, or kids/teens
- Willingness to panel with select insurance plans and accept sliding scale clients
- Invested in anti-racist efforts, and pursues social justice in their personal and professional lives
- Consistently completes documentation in a timely manner, and prioritizes organization and prompt communication to colleagues & clients
- An independent worker who knows when to ask for help and how they prefer to receive feedback
- Willingness and interest in social media, blogs, and video as a means of engaging and marketing to new clients
- Interest in learning the small business side of private practice
- Weekday and weekend availability to (maintain a caseload of 20+ clients weekly (flexibility to start with part-time and grow into full-time)
- Open to and interested in opportunities of co-therapy with other therapists in the practice
